

#### Homework

Homework will continue to be set on a Thursday, this is when school books will be coming home with the children. Please could children read three times a week for 20 minutes with an adult or older sibling. Please could the adult who has read with the child, fill in the reading records after each session. We are continuing to have big push on times tables this term, so please make sure your child is practising on TT Rockstar's at least 3 times a week for 15-20 minutes.

### P.E.

P.E. days this term are Tuesday and Friday. Children should come to school dressed in their P.E. kit on this day so they do not need to change before and after the lesson.



Kit should include: Trainers or plimsolls; a plain white t-shirt or a school P.E. top; shorts or tracksuit bottoms (black) and a hooded fleece or jumper for outdoor P.E. Children can wear their school jumper over the top of P.E. kit during the day.

Any stud earrings must be taped or removed for safety.

### <u>Reminders</u>

Children will need the following equipment EVERY day:

- Suitable clothing for the weather (coat, gloves, hat)
- A school bag to bring home any books.
- A reading book.
- A healthy snack. e.g. fruit, vegetables, crackers.
- Water bottle (this should be left in the classroom during the day and taken home regularly for cleaning).
