SATs Preparation

Term 4 is an important time of year in the preparation for the End of KS2 SATs in May. Throughout the term, we will be running booster sessions in the afternoon for reading and maths, as well as morning booster sessions for spelling, punctuation and grammar. In addition, we will be sending out revision books for some pupils. All other pupils will be given access to many different revision websites and resources. Over the Easter Holiday, we will be emphasising to the children that doing homework 'little and often' is far better than spending many hours in one day. Therefore, the work we set is designed to give the children approximately 25-30 minutes of work, 5 days-a-week. Supporting your child with their homework and revision is more likely to have a positive impact than if they complete it alone, and we recommend you do so where possible, whilst being mindful that the strategies being taught in class may differ to those you have been taught at school.
